People who showed up to media day but have not paid their membership dues: If going to enter a contest have to join NOW. NSPA has a filter inside their contest system. We do as well -- have to update the member list before we open contest.
 - d. Compare lists before the contest b/c going into the system to fix the enrollment could be problematic.

- f. Palo Alto event has been influential in increasing membership b/c it's free and it's one day. And our income is fine.
- g. Annual contest also helps--our contest is the only contest that middle schools can enter where students get the awards before the end of the school year..

- B. Registration money goes to local committee. We receive money from the national convention and that helps us with many of the things we want to do.
- C. \$646.42 was a late payment, we spent 500 more than we had. As a non-profit we are able to support some scholarships.
- D. Difficult to tell the difference between membership and contest money when all the money comes in all at once.
- E. Don's been working with PayPal to change the account name to his own.
- F. If there is confusion or if the numbers are off it is because the money is hard to differentiate between membership and contest. Sometimes confusion if name on PayPal does not match their name because they get married, etc.

E. Revamp of website

- A. Has taken Herculean strides lately. We've decided to go with School Newspapers Online that offers a free platform for state journalism programs. There should be a change in the website this week. SNO now owns the URL but will sell it back to us if needed. The new by-laws are there. Old material has been taken off. Kristy posted current material there about winners from NorCal Media Day. We need a commissioner there to put new content on the website.
- B. Paul has put a new "How to Get Your Course Approved for UC credit" under resources on the website. He may ask people to look at it to give input. Would like to put current models up of schools. Anything labeled 2014 is not a good model. We should be able to identify schools.
- C. Tripp went to Casey Nichols presentation two years ago at NorCal Media Day and learned enough to get UCSF (arts) credit, now in 2nd year.
