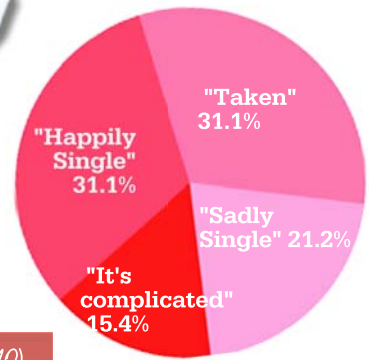
WHAT WOULD YOU GIVE YOUR VALENTINE -- IF YOU HAD ONE?
