

# THE HORNER HIVE-OLOGISTS

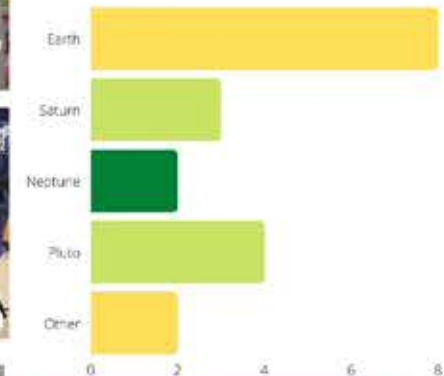
