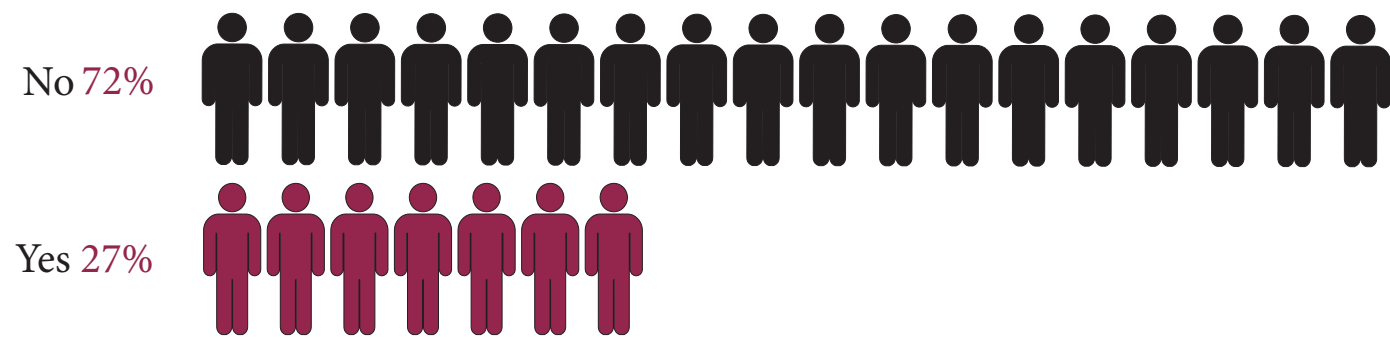


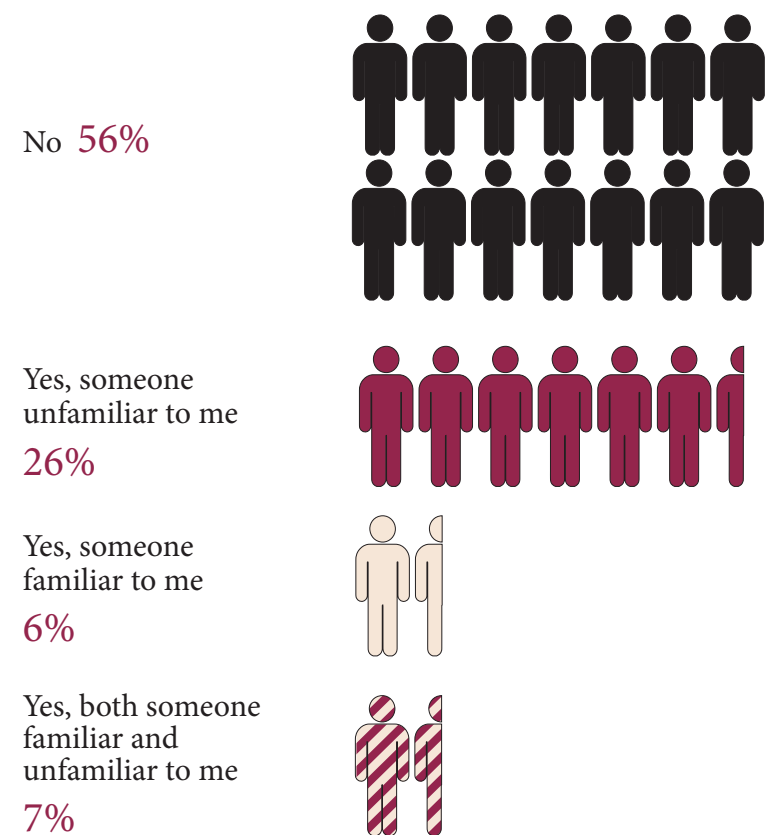
Survey of Menlo Upper School Students

The survey was conducted at Menlo Upper School on Jan. 20, 2023 via paper questionnaires handed out to three gender-balanced advocacy groups from each grade, nine-12. The response rate was 100%. The sample size was 116. The Confidence Level was 95% and the Margin of Error was +/-8.6%. It's important to consider what Margin of Error means: for each percentage reported here, the true value could be up to 8.6% higher or lower. So for a value shown of 72%, the actual value should be between 63.4% and 80.6%.

1% of students surveyed report having been **physically** or **sexually** abused by a romantic partner

5% of students surveyed report having been **emotionally** or **verbally** abused by a romantic partner

6% of students surveyed said they have experienced sexual assault.

Sexual assault defined as "sexual contact or other behavior that occurs without explicit consent of the survivor."

13% of all students (nationally) have experienced sexual assault.

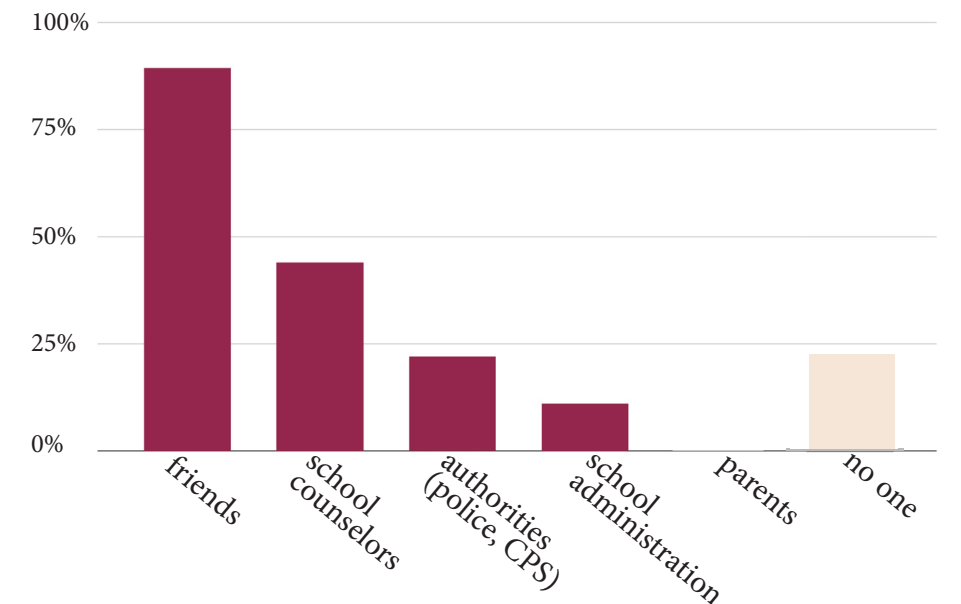
SOLUTIONS
