

## BEY AREA or swiftie clara?

The arrival of Taylor Swift and Beyoncé to the South Bay for their concerts were not just iconic musical feats, but also social phenomena.

• • • • In the wake of the record-breaking success of Taylor Swift's Eras Tour and Beyoncé's Renaissance Tour, the Bay Area decided to feed into the frenzy. The Santa Clara Council handed over temporary mayorship, along with keys to city, to both of the singers for a day. However, the city of Santa Clara wasn't the only one handing out gifts, with her tour which made an estimated \$4.1 billion, according to NASDAQ, Swift donated an undisclosed "generous" amount of money to Silicon Valley's Second Harvest Food Bank. Additionally, ABC 7 San Francisco reported that the Renaissance tour brought a noticeable boost to black-owned, women-owned and LGBTQ businesses selling Beyoncé themed products, affectionately deemed the "Beyoncé Bump." Their presence was cited by San Jose Mercury News as a source of tens of millions of dollars to the local
