Keep going...keep dreaming big. We have no doubt you will make it through!

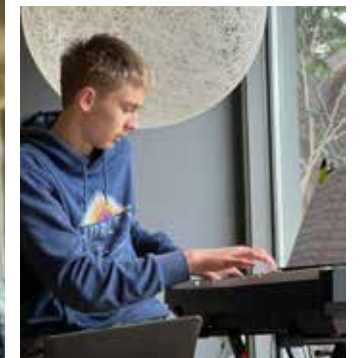
