

## swimzone

Henry Hu (10) opens a swim lesson business for young children

Competitive swimming was not the only way Hu made a splash in his community. Hu dedicated hours to coaching local children the basics of water safety through his business called Swimzone.

One factor Hu kept in mind when starting Swimzone was creating a schedule that would fit his clients' availability.

"Our entire [business] model is to make it as convenient as possible for the parents," Hu said. "I had a few more people come help me teach because I have more clients and schedules to keep track of."

To gain an advantage over other local swimming classes, Hu reached out to local instructors.

"All our coaches are teenagers, and we have a lot of experience in swimming," Hu said. "Furthermore, our pricing is really low compared to others, [as] we offer lessons for about \$40.00 per hour when the market average in this area is about \$80.00."

As an experienced swimmer, Hu wanted to ensure that all children were able to have the opportunity to learn how to swim.

"I know a lot of parents who want their kids to swim, so I want to produce a positive impact on my community," Hu said.
